Any Suggestions:

The governing body members given the following suggestions for the improvement of the Institutions.

- > UG Students research paper publications can be encouraged through awards / incentives
- ➤ Q1 & Q2 open access journals with more than 2 impact factor publication charge can be provided
- > Average citations per faculty can be analyzed
- > Separate budget for research and development to be allotted by the institute
- > Target to be given to individual dept for consultancy works, separate director or Head to be appointed for consultancy works
- > Full time scholar stipend to be increased
- > Seed money for start-ups to be initialized with proper policy
- > Technology transfer to be started for granted patents
- > Industrial Training to be undergone by faculty members need to be considered for promotion
- ➤ All the events and activities to be mapped with SDGs
- > Value added courses outcome collect the 2 to 3 minutes videos from students
- > Amount Generated through workshops/Seminars/Conferences through each dept need to improve





- German and French courses can be introduced, and feedback can be collected from industry
- ➤ Alumni Head / Director can be appointed to facilitate the chapters, Corpus Funds to be generated dept wise. Dept wise alumni meet can be arranged in campus
- > Student exchange program to be strengthened
- > Fix the higher target to improve the Highest salary package offers.
