# Minutes of the 5th Research Advisory Board (RAB) Meeting Held on 17th Sep. 2022 at 10.00 AM.

The Chairperson welcomed all the members to the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the RAB and apprised the members about College strong research base and stated that several of the faculty members are involved in sponsored research in addition to doctoral research supervision.

He briefed the members that there are many research areas in which the College needs to move faster hence the College felt it would be advantageous to set up focused research centers in terms of research as against academic.

He stated that the College expects to be advised by the Research Advisory Board members to provide a focused direction towards all research activities.

#### Discussion

1. The Journal Paper publication target of the faculty and students are 599 (290+309) for the Academic year 2021-22 which includes SCI/E, Scopus and WoS indexed journals, but the target achieved is 466, 16 patents and 1 copy rights remaining 93 papers are under review.

The RAB members are noted the status of the journal publications for the last year and appreciated the progress of SCI/E publications compare to previous years like 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

The RAB members asked the reasons for lagging in publication count compared to 2020-21.

The members of various departments are given explanations like under review and given assurance for next academic year to meet out the target.

The target for Patent publication is 132 for the Academic year 2021-22 but the target achieved is 119. The RAB members are noted the status of the patent publication and appreciated our team effort.

3. The Amount generation through the Research Projects have fixed for all departments are 1.3 Crore for the Academic year 2021-22. But amount generated through the Research Projects are Rs.16.96 Lakhs.

The RAB members are noted the status of the fund generation through the Funded Projects and asked the reasons for the lagging in fund generation.

The members of various departments are given explanations like most of the applied projects are in review stage and surely it will be sanctioned.

- Collaborative research is required with inter-dept. for applying funding and publication.
- Funded projects can be applied for various funding agencies and improve publication through funding and can produce Ph.D candidates.
- Domain wise faculty have to be identified for research collaboration.
- Initiatives must be taken in emerging areas where lots of funds are available.
- List of proposal submitted slides can be added to the presentation slides.
- Faculties acting as reviewers in reputed journals can be added to the presentation slides.


