


Objectives

- To prevent the use of drugs and other illegal substances among students.
- To create awareness through Heads, Class Advisor, seminars, campaigns, and counseling programs.
- To identify and support students struggling with substance abuse.
- To ensure compliance with government and university regulations regarding drug control.
- To promote a healthy, disciplined, and productive learning environment.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Organize awareness programs, guest lectures, and rallies.
- Display posters and information about the dangers of drug abuse.
- Monitor student behavior and identify early signs of substance use.
- Conduct confidential counseling and refer cases for professional help if needed.
- Take disciplinary action in coordination with college authorities for violations.
- The committee shall meet at least **once every semester** to review activities and effectiveness

Code of Conduct for Students

- Students must **not possess, consume, or distribute** any narcotic substances.
- Violation will result in **strict disciplinary action**, including suspension, rustication, or legal action as per NDPS Act.
- Students should report any suspected drug-related activities to the committee confidentially.

Disciplinary Action

Any student found guilty of drug possession or usage will face:

1. Immediate suspension from classes.
2. Counseling and parent intimation.
3. Possible expulsion based on severity.
4. Reporting to local authorities if necessary
