Anti-Ragging Committee

Introduction

Ragging is strictly prohibited in any form inside or outside the campus. It is a criminal offense under the Indian Penal Code and punishable under law. The institution is committed to providing a **safe, respectful, and inclusive environment** for all students. The **Anti-Ragging Committee** is established as per the regulations of the **University Grants Commission (UGC)** and the **All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)** to ensure that no act of ragging takes place and that appropriate measures are taken for prevention and redressal.

Objectives

The primary objectives of the Anti-Ragging Committee are to:

1. Ensure a **ragging-free campus** and promote a culture of mutual respect among students.
2. Implement preventive measures as per **AICTE/UGC guidelines**.
3. Create **awareness** about the harmful effects and legal consequences of ragging.
4. Establish a **transparent mechanism** for lodging and resolving complaints.
5. Ensure **timely disciplinary action** against any student found guilty of ragging

Functions of the Committee

1. Conduct **awareness activities** and **orientation sessions** for new students.
2. Display **anti-ragging posters, circulars, and helpline numbers** in prominent places.
3. Receive and address complaints promptly and confidentially.
4. Conduct **regular meetings (twice a year)** to review preventive actions.
5. Submit reports to the **Principal / University / AICTE** as required.
6. Coordinate with local police or authorities in serious cases.



Rules and Regulations

1. Ragging in any form — physical, verbal, emotional, or cyber — is **strictly prohibited**.
2. Students must **maintain discipline and respect** toward peers and faculty members.
3. Violation of rules will lead to disciplinary action, including:
 - o Warning or counseling
 - o Suspension or expulsion
 - o Debarment from examinations or College
 - o FIR with local police as per severity of offense
4. The committee shall meet **at least twice in an academic year** — once in the **Odd Semester** and once in the **Even Semester**.
5. Minutes of meetings and action-taken reports shall be recorded and maintained
